Thank you, thank you, to those who have already contributed to the Boulder Mountain Fire Protection District (BMFPD) Station 2 rebuild campaign. To date, almost 40% of our community has given! The thermometers on the campaign signs in your neighborhood are tracking campaign progress. Let's keep them moving up.

At the Station 2 groundbreaking ceremony in July, Mike and Janet, Boulder Heights residents, shared their experience with BMFPD when their house was struck by lightning:



A few years ago, our house was struck by lightning, during a snowstorm. We were returning from town at the time. The early season snow was making the roads bad. Luckily, a neighbor called 911 and texted to let us know our home was burning. Another neighbor who is a firefighter went directly to our house to size up the situation and communicate with the firefighters coming to the scene.

After suiting up at Station 2, the firefighters deployed to the scene and immediately put water on the fire. Then, as other firefighters responded, a county snowplow went into a ditch and blocked the main road from Deer Trail to our home. Fast-thinking firefighters from Station 1 in Pine Brook were able to get to the scene via the back way through Carriage Hills and helped put out the fire.

Most of our home was saved, and damage was confined largely to one side of the house. Having a fire station and responders in our own neighborhood was the only way that such quick action was possible. Having multiple fire stations made it possible to get all the department's resources to the fire, which kept us from losing the entire house.

Thankfully, we are back in our home after rebuilding. BMFPD was there for us—they will be there for you too.
